- ◆ Normal operating hours 1030 to 1830 but we are flexible.
- ◆ Booking ahead is essential to ensure a seat.
- ◆ No advanced payment required. A small deposit is required if you charter the boat.
- ◆ Prices available on our website.
- ◆ Arrive at least 20 minutes before sailing.
- ◆ Our booking office is a blue portacabin positioned next to the coastguard station.
- ◆ Wear a face covering during the checking in process within our small office.
- ◆ Free parking and toilets available.
- ◆ Sea tours suitable for 4 plus, except for some of the specialised tours.
- ◆ Harbour tours for all ages (except infants).
- ◆ Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ Carries twelve passengers. Family friendly seating.
- ◆ Boarding is easy (Hydraulic chair lift available on Wick Marina for those with restricted mobility).
- ◆ It is an open boat so wear warm clothes, hats, jumpers, fleeces, jackets and suitable footwear. Also bring gloves if you suffer from cold hands.
- ◆ Waterproof clothing is provided.
- ◆ Life Jackets provided and must be worn.
- ◆ Safety equipment meets the Maritime and Coastguard Agency regulations.
- ◆ Boat and skipper are fully licensed.
- ◆ If a trip is cancelled a full refund will be given.
- ◆ Minimum passenger numbers applies for each tour.
- ◆ Most major credit and debit cards accepted.

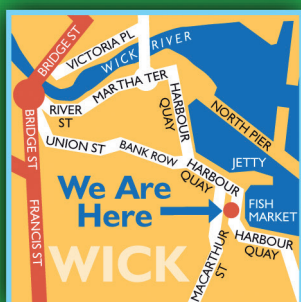

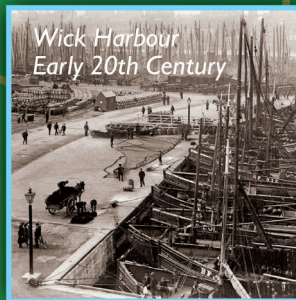

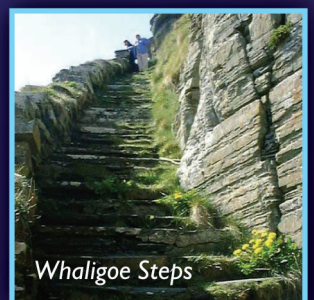
